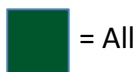


UNC CHARLOTTE'S MUSIC MAJOR PREVIEW: AUDITION WORKSHOP

What Should I Prepare?

If possible, we encourage students to prepare standard repertoire, for example:

Vocalists: One or two contrasting selections from the musical theatre and/or classical repertoire (from memory is preferred). Musical Theater and Classical voice students must bring copies of sheet music. A pianist will be provided.

Instrumentalists: One or two contrasting selections that best represent your performance ability. Both selections should be solo works written for your specific instrument, such as an etude, sonata or concerto. Percussionists should prepare solo pieces in two of the following three categories: mallets, snare drum, and timpani.
