Outlined below is the curriculum for the Dual Degree which includes the accredited professional Master of Architecture (MArch) and the Master of Urban Design (MUD) degrees at UNC Charlotte. The Dual Degee requires 51 cr. hr. in Architecture (for Advanced Standing students with 4-year degrees from NAAB accredited architecture programs) and 33 cr. hr. in Urban Design, during 6 fall/spring terms, and a full-time summer that includes a 10-week studio, and two courses (5 weeks of the summer curriculum are completed in a MUDD study abroad program).
