Ensemble Director

Will Campbell is the Director of Jazz Studies and Professor of Saxophone at UNC Charlotte. He holds the DMA degree from the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign and the BM and MM from the University of North Texas. While attending UNT, he was a member of the One O'Clock Lab Band and directed the Three O'Clock Lab Band. Since 1999. he has been a member of the University of North Texas Summer Jazz Workshop Faculty and has also been invited to direct All-State Jazz Bands in New Mexico, Oklahoma, South Carolina, and North Carolina. From 1990 to 1994, he toured internationally and recorded with the Harry Connick, Jr. Orchestra. His debut recording, Think Tank, is available on Cellar Live Records. In a review of Think Tank for All About Jazz, Raul d'Gama Rose stated, "Campbell is always meticulous in his pace, letting his warm, fat tone sing out as he constructs solos of breathtaking resonance." In 2015, Campbell was a co-leader on the debut recording of the Unhinged Sextet, Clarity (OA2 Records), contributing as a composer and performer. Clarity has received glowing reviews and international airplay.
